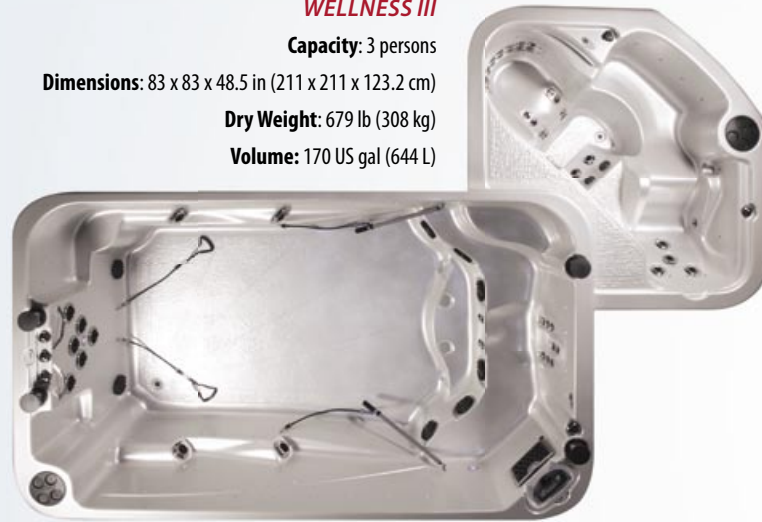

By contrast, the benefits of immersing a human body in a vessel of warm water have been known and understood for centuries.

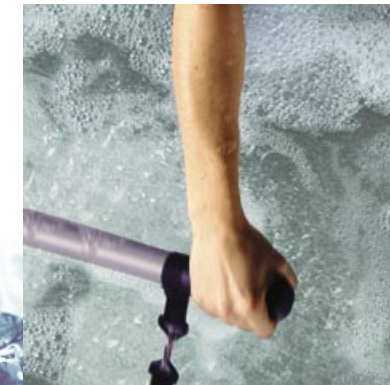
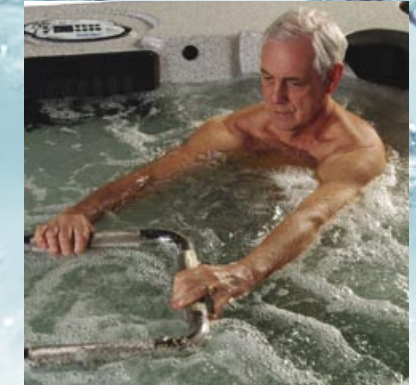
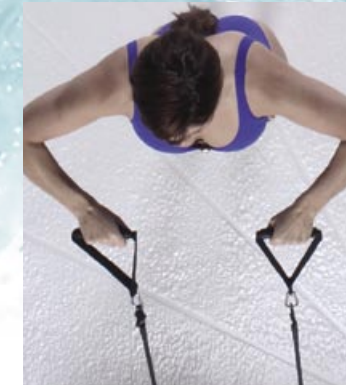

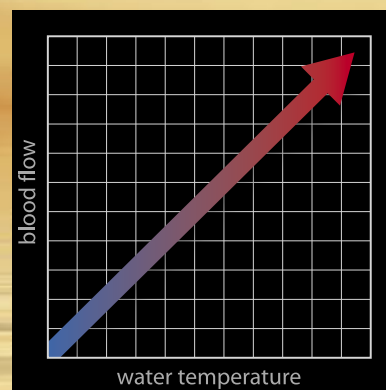
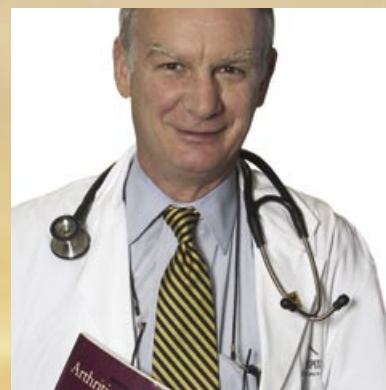
A history of natural healing

Humanity's love affair with water dates back to the dawn of time. For washing, drinking, growing and living, we simply can't do without it. Merely immersing yourself in warm water is beneficial; water's greater-than-atmospheric pressure stimulates greater cardiac output and a slower pulse, while the warm temperatures dilate blood vessels to boost circulation and encourage the body to release mood-improving hormones. Increased circulation further speeds the flow of nutrients to help heal and regenerate cells and flush away pain-causing chemicals. Delivered under the pressure of hydrotherapy, warm water loosens tight muscles, stimulates the immune system, invigorates the circulation and digestive systems and reduces pain sensitivity.

Warm water is especially advantageous for exercise, particularly for individuals suffering from arthritis or rheumatism. It supports up to 90 percent of body weight, relieving pressure on joints caused by gravity, and freeing limbs to perform exercises that would not be possible on land. At the same time, water's high density provides superior resistance to movement, enhancing the effects of strength-building exercises.

It was with the arthritic patient in mind that we developed our original Wellness Spa — with the able assistance of the Arthritis Research Centre of Canada and its Scientific Director, Dr. John Esdaile.

Three Days to Wellness

Our partnership with the Arthritis Research Centre of Canada (ARC) made our original Wellness Spa (right) a lot less painful to design – and more important, to use. Valuable input from ARC staff and volunteers led to innovations like an exterior handrail for comfortable entry and exit, a non-skid surface for safer footing, and a new line of jets – our Trillium Series – controlled by levers that even sore hands can adjust with ease. We designed the seats and footwells to accommodate all body types, and added a stainless steel balance ring to give extra support.

As public demand for better health and fitness grew, so did our thinking. The result of which is the latest evolution of our Wellness Series. The Wellness II (far right) is a dedicated cooler-water swim spa. With its four Hi-Flow Swim Spa pumps supplying a strong, steady frontal current, and four bottom-mounted Levitator Jets working to help keep you afloat, it's like having your own full-size pool in a fraction of the space. When the swimming stops, the detachable oars and exercise bands are great ways to build extra muscle definition. And when you're ready to unwind, let the warm water, relaxing lounge seat and hydrotherapy jets of the attached Wellness III Spa work their magic. Ahhhh.



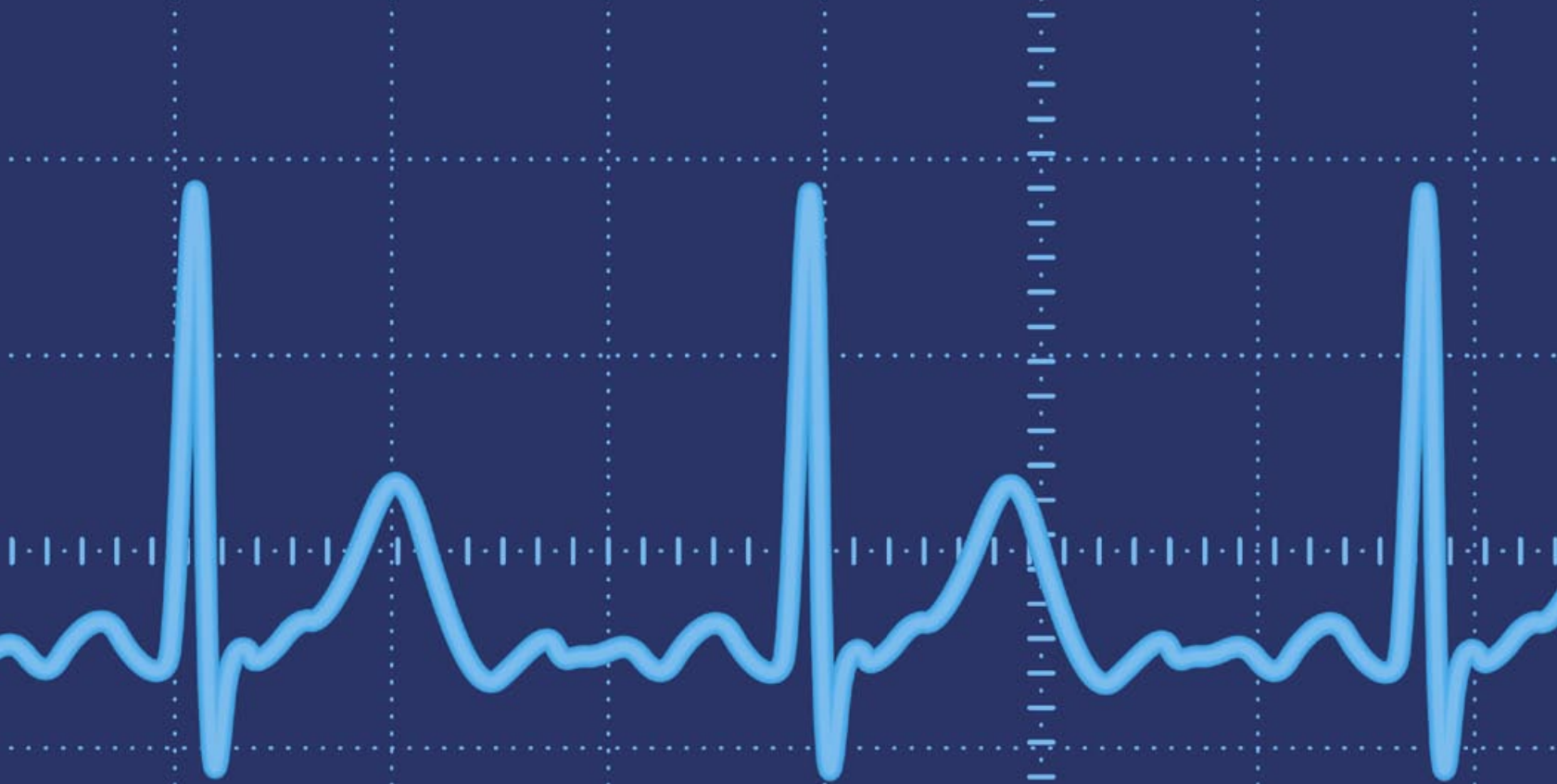
Original Wellness Spa (left page), Wellness Spa II (above) and Wellness Spa III (immediate left, optional on Wellness II).

frontal force of six powerful swim jets. Thanks to the extra water depth in both the Wellness I and II, you'll be almost completely immersed while you're exercising or enjoying your hydrotherapy massage.

And the ergonomically designed position of the jets means you get maximum therapeutic benefit for your sore arms, legs, back, neck and feet.
